#### WHEN SHOULD I GO TO THE HOSPITAL?

- If you think you're in **labour**
- If you think your water breaks
- If you are having new vaginal bleeding
- If you are concerned about a decrease or change in baby's movements
- If you are having a severe headache or not feeling well
- If you are in a car accident, experience a fall or trauma
- If you have any concerns for yourself or your baby

#### WHERE DO I REGISTER?

- For unscheduled visits proceed to Women and Babies triage and register on our unit
- For scheduled visits refer to the registration process from your doctor's office
- Proceed to the Main Entrance between 7am to 11pm and Emergency Department entrance between 11pm to 7am
