

### Information for Patients and Family Members

We support patients and their families. It is important for patients to take part in planning their care and encourage them to include their families in the planning too. To help this happen, we ask that patients choose one person as a contact for their family and/or loved ones. Make sure your team has that person's name and contact information.

It is natural for family members to be concerned. The team has more time to spend with your family member if the contact person can make sure information is shared with the people the patient chooses.

#### **APPOINTMENT CHANGES**

#### ASSISTED TRANSPORTATION

If you need a ride to get to or from the hospital there are transportation services available.

#### **OPT - Ontario Patient Transfer**

The patient is responsible to pay for this service. They are able to transfer patients by wheelchair, stretcher or someone who can walk but needs assistance.

You can call the day of and get the next available vehicle but if you call the day before you can book the time you will be picked up.

This service has a one-time registration fee that is paid by the patient. They are able to drive patients who can walk or transfer themselves from a wheelchair.

This service needs **3 business days** to make sure a volunteer is available to pick you up:

If you need a ride on Monday – call the Wednesday before, by 12:00PM

If you need a ride on **Tuesday – call the Thursday before**, by 12:00PM

If you need a ride on Wednesday – call the Friday before, by 12:00PM

If you need a ride on **Thursday – call the Monday before**, by 12:00PM

If you need a ride on Friday – call the Tuesday before, by 12:00PM
