







Child and Youth Mental Health and Addictions Community Supports

- All referrals for child and youth mental health, developmental and autism services are to be sent to

- Clients/families are **NOT** monitored while on any waitlists and need to be monitored/supported by their primary care provider.
- International students are required to access their private medical coverage for all associated fees.

<u>Psychiatric Consultation (NIAGARA HEALTH ONLY)</u> A consultation with a psychiatrist, is with someone, who specializes in diagnostic clarification and pharmacological treatment of <u>mental health</u> <u>disorders</u>. This includes a comprehensive evaluation of the psychological, biological, medical and social causes to obtain a medical opinion and recommendations regarding specific symptom(s) management.

The psychiatric consultation is <u>NOT</u> an ongoing counselling/therapy program. This is a <u>one-time psychiatric</u> <u>consultation</u> with the understanding that the referring primary care provider is responsible for the implementation of recommendations.
