The Department of Obstetrics/Gynecology at Niagara Health delivers 24/7, comprehensive Level 2B Maternal and Level 2C Neonatal Services providing low to high-risk care to patients within the Niagara region catchment area. Our Women's and Babies Program delivered 3340 babies in 20/21; we are currently projected to deliver 3780 this year.

Surgical services provide a total OR surgical case volume of ~ 1500 per year of which ~1000 are day stay cases. The Program offers full scope minimally invasive laparoscopic surgery.
