The Department of Obstetrics/Gynecology at Niagara Health delivers 24/7, comprehensive Level 2B Maternal and Level 2C Neonatal Services providing low to high-risk care to patients within the Niagara region catchment area. Our Women’s and Babies Program delivered 3340 babies in 20/21; we are currently projected to deliver 3780 this year.

Surgical services provide a total OR surgical case volume of ~ 1500 per year of which ~1000 are day stay cases. The Program offers full scope minimally invasive laparoscopic surgery. The team provides an equal share of OR time to all members of the Department that is responsive to clinical need and OR utilization.

Niagara Health is a regional healthcare provider with multiple sites and a growing network of community-based and virtual services.
