



RESCHEDULING A TASK, REHAB RESCHEDULE REASON NOTE

OCCUPATIONAL THERAPIST, PHYSIOTHERAPIST, SPEECH-LANGUAGE PATHOLOGIST, RECREATIONAL THERAPIST, COMMUNICATIVE DISORDERS ASSISTANT


If a patient does not consent or is deemed by the treating therapist to be inappropriate for assessment, the end-user will reschedule the Assessment task within 7 days or 168 hours of the original Consult Order placement. This approach ensures the task remains in the Multi Patient Task List, enabling the end-user to complete the Assessment and attach the Assessment documentation to the Consult Order.

Note: a task can only be rescheduled via the MPTL; once the task is rescheduled, the task timer will reset. When rescheduled, these changes will also reschedule the tasks within the Rehab Organizer.




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



Once the note has been completed and signed, a folder will maintain them and can be easily found according to the title "Rehabilitation Notes", subfolder "Rehab Reschedule Reason"
The **Rehab Reschedule Reason** Note becomes visible for any end-user to see within the patient's PowerChart.



RESCHEDULING A TASK, REHAB RESCHEDULE REASON NOTE

Caution:

When the end-user right-clicks the task on the MPTL, they should **NOT** choose “Chart Not Done”.



If chosen, the task will disappear and will flip the consult order to a “Completed” status. When this occurs, it will demonstrate to the prescriber that the assessment was completed, when it may not have been. When the end-user goes to see the patient later, the end-user will have to AD HOC their assessment powerform, disconnecting it from the original consult order.

The “Completed” status for the below Interprofessional Consult, indicates to the prescriber the assessment was complete.
