



INITIATING POWERPLANS - NURSING

MRPs can place a PowerPlan in a “Planned” state, allowing the nurse to “Initiate” the PowerPlan at the appropriate time.

1. In CareCompass, the nurse can review within the **Plan of Care** column any PowerPlans that are ordered in an Initiated or Planned state. If the order is new or placed into a planned state, the orange notification will be seen beside this. The nurse can click on this and it will navigate them to that PowerPlan.




2. The nurse can review the Medical Plans and locate any PowerPlans that are in a “Planned State”.



3. The nurse will select the Planned state order. Once selected, a button will appear at the bottom right showing “Initiate Now”. Once the nurse is ready for this order to be initiated, they will select this button.



- Once the “Initiate Now” button is selected, a pop-up will appear asking for the communication type for the order. The nurse will select “Initiate Plan’ communication type for this order.


