**Start/Stop [87]**

Description: Access the Connect Nursing Application. Log on using Millennium credentials or PIN in if already logged on.

**Work Step [5]**

Description: Select the correct patient from Patient List or scan patient wristband to open the patient's chart.

**Work Step [6]**

Description: If not previously done, establish a relationship to view the patient's chart. Select continue to open patient's chart

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**Work Step [8]**

Description: Tap the table of contents icon at the top left of the patient summary screen.

**Work Step [9]**

Description: Tap the "Specimen Collections" option in the table of contents.

**Work Step [10]**

Description: Review specimen collection activities from the Activity List.

**Work Step [21]**

Description: Tap the filter icon to manage filters or create personal filter. Tap the "Apply" button to save filter settings.

**Work Step [19]**

Description: Tap on a specimen to see additional details and verify collection container.

**Work Step [22]**

Description: Tap the "Select All" box or choose individual specimens to be collected.

**Work Step [23]**

Description: Scan the patient wristband if not previously completed.

**Decision [38]**

Description: Was the scan successful?

**Work Step [39]**

Description: Tap the options/ellipsis icon (...) and tap "Collect". Choose an appropriate reason, tap "Apply" and then "Sign".

**Work Step [32]**

Description: Scan the wireless label printer Barcode or QR code (facility specific). Or manually enter the printer code in the field.

**Work Step [33]**

Description: Tap "Print".

**Work Step [34]**

Description: Collect specimens as appropriate, following your facilities protocols.

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**Decision [35]**

Description: Was the specimen collected?

**Work Step [53]**

Description: Apply the previously printed label to the collection container. Then scan the collection label to confirm collection.

**Decision [58]**

Description: Was the Scan successful?

**Decision [36]**

Description: Is the specimen still needed?

**Work Step [59]**

Description: Tap the "Sign" button.

**Start/Stop [63]**

Description: End user receives sign successful notification. Continue to monitor for new specimen collection activities.

**System [83]**

Description: The collection job will be removed from the list. If the specimen is needed at a later date/time a new order will need placed.

**Work Step [37]**

Description: Tap the options/ellipsis icon (...) and Tap "Not Collected" and select an appropriate reason. Then "Apply"

Description: Contact provider for additional directions or order modification.
