





- 4) After patient delivery, remember to  all maternal information to newborn chart if not already completed
- 5) From the patient's chart, select **Women's Health View** and click on **Discharge Workflow** MPage




- 6) Navigate to **Discharge Documentation** in the grey table of contents
 - o From the down arrow to the right of the page, select the **OB Maternal Discharge** PowerForm. Complete the PowerForm and click the green checkmark ✓ to sign.




- 7) Within the **Discharge** MPage, scroll down the grey table of contents to the Create Note section. Select the **WH Discharge Instructions**. Review the discharge information and follow ups for the birth parent






8) Select **Sign/Submit** at the bottom of the window




9) Then select, **Sign & Print**



10) Navigate to the **Women's Health View**. Select the **Postpartum MPage** and click on the **Pregnancy Overview** Component from the grey menu




11) To the right of the page, select **Close Pregnancy**




12) Close pregnancy window opens. Fields will automatically populate from IView documentation. Any problems associated with this pregnancy will be marked as resolved once pregnancy is closed. Click **Submit**.

13) Pregnancy Summary Document is generated and viewable in the **Documentation** section of the blue table of contents and historical pregnancies are updated

- 14) **Note: To review the newborn discharge process, please see the Newborn Discharge Tip sheet**
- 15) To discharge the patient in the system once they leave the unit, single-click the patient's row in the tracking board and click the Rocket ship icon. Then select **Discharge Encounter**




- 16) Fill in the required fields in the discharge registration conversation, then press **Complete**

- 17) Since mom and baby are linked, a Newborn Discharge Dialog box opens. Right-click anywhere on baby's row and select the applicable action:
- Copy Discharge: If baby is discharged at the same time as mom, this will copy the discharge information and discharge baby from the system
 - Modify Discharge: If there are any modifications to be done to the discharge details for baby. Once completed, this will discharge baby from the system
 - If baby is not discharging with mom, press **Cancel**
